Collective Membership

Thank you for your interest in joining The Painted Moose Artist Collective! This collective art gallery is owned and operated by all members of the collective; Please visit the website to see a list of current members.

Membership in this collective is open to artists living in Bragg Creek and surrounding communities, included but not limited to Okotoks, Black Diamond, Turner Valley, Cochrane, Airdrie, Strathmore and Calgary. Artists are selected as space becomes available. Each new artist must go through a jurying process prior to being selected to be part of the collective.

The Painted Moose Artist Collective retains 3% from all Collective Member art sales. This 3% is used to pay for credit and debit processing fees on all sales and for incidentals such as advertising, cleaning supplies, bags, and other approved items.

All new members must commit to staying with the collective for a minimum of 12 months. New members are required to pay a one time membership fee of \$150.00 plus first and last months rent before moving art into the premises. Rent is calculated based on the number of artists in the collective membership. At the time of writing rent is \$180.00 per month. Rent will be re-assessed from time to time as artists join and leave the collective (gallery operating expenses divided by the number of members).

All members are required to work for the gallery a minimum of 4 days per month. The number of days is calculated by the number of days open divided by the number of artists in the collective and can change from time to time.

APPLICATION INSTRUCTIONS

Please send 6 digital images (jpg's) of your work along with this completed application form to info@thepaintedmoose.ca. The Collective will review your application and contact you within 1-2 weeks.

Artists who make it through the jury process will be invited to a monthly collective members meeting. You will be required to bring in the actual pieces of art previously submitted digitally. These items should be representative of what you would be selling in the Painted Moose. Please be prepared as you will be required to speak briefly about why you became an artist, your background and information about your art. Please be prepared to respond to members' questions about your art.

MEMBERSHIP REQUIREMENTS

1. Sign a 12 month Collective Membership contract and abide by all terms. Read and be familiar with The Painted Moose Artist Collective policy and procedures.
2. Become familiar with payment system, and handling, packaging of each artist's work.
3. Work a minimum of 4 days per month.
4. Be a contributing member of the group.
5. Attend as many monthly General Meetings of the collective as possible.
